



WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

The PMP / CAPM Exam Prep Workshop is a 35 hour class designed to prepare candidates to sit for and pass the PMP or CAPM certification exams. Experienced instructors holding the PMP certification guide participants through the material from the PMI Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®) 5th Edition. The workshop is intended to familiarize participants with the PMBOK model; it is not intended to be an introduction to project management. Rather, the goal is to prepare students to pass the PMP / CAPM certification exams. The workshop is a service provided by the PMI Tucson chapter to benefit prospective PMP holders.

WORKSHOP DATES
